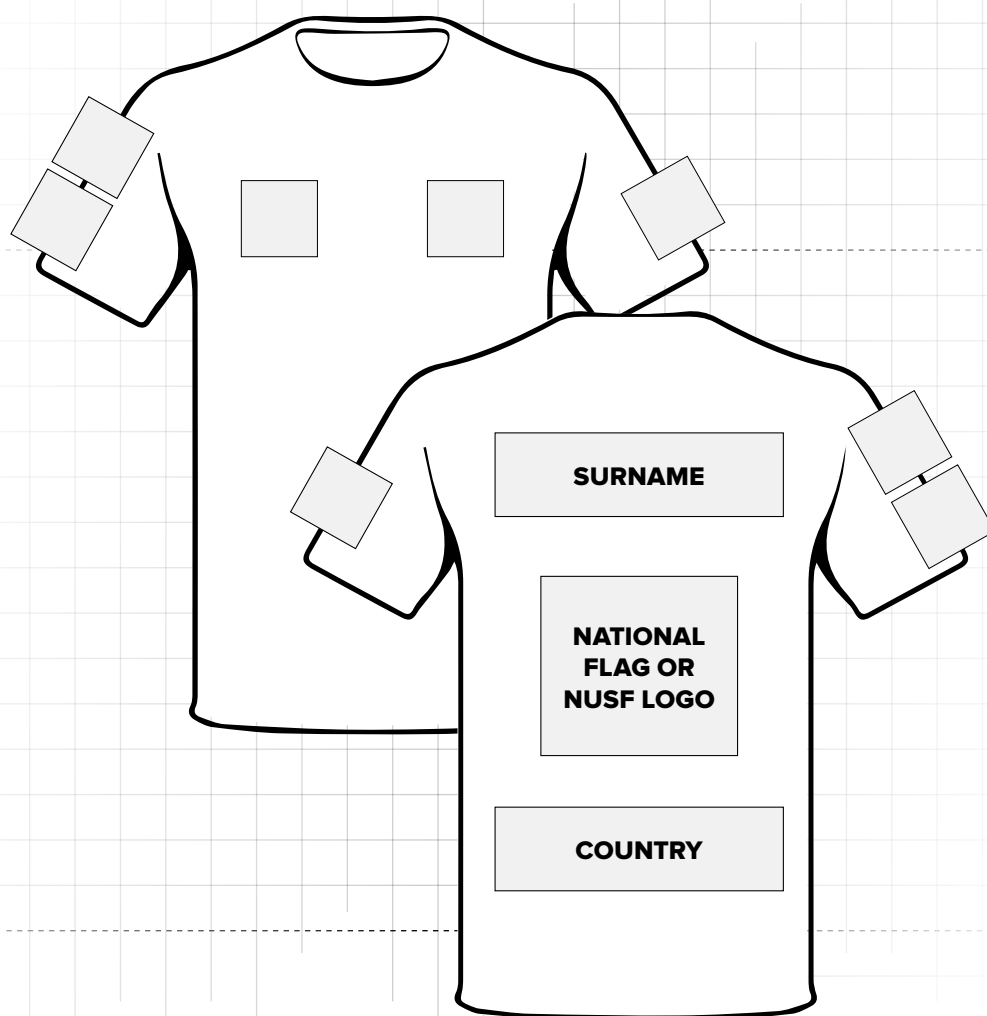

Curling Uniforms Policy

The competition uniforms must be in accordance with the regulations of the appropriate International Sports Federations, except when specifically amended by FISU Regulations and FISU Uniform Guidelines.

For the Winter Universiade Curling Competition FISU adopts the WCF's rules and guidelines for Uniforms/Equipment and Cresting except when specifically amended with this guideline.

Please refer to: WCF Rules of Competition - C3 - Uniform/Equipment and Dress Code.

Any logos or advertising that are not following these rules must be removed/hidden from the uniforms.

NUSF shall be primarily responsible for ensuring that the uniforms comply with those rules and guidelines. Submission process is not mandatory, but it is highly recommended to send the uniform layout to FISU (winter.universiade@fisu.net) for review in order to avoid any possible uniform-related-issue during the Winter Universiade.

PLAYERS' UNIFORM

Each team member shall wear identical uniforms for all games.

Each garment (shirt, jacket or sweater) shall have:

- the player's surname in 5cm letters across the upper back of the garment,
- the country name in 5cm, or larger letters, across the back above the waist.
- If desired, a national emblem may also be worn on the back, but only in addition to the country name and should be displayed between the player's surname and the country name.

When two players have the same surname, the first letter of their given name shall be added to the player's name on the garment. If the first letter is also the same either another initial should be added, or the full or abbreviated given names shown.

Colours

The members of a team shall wear light-coloured shirts and playing jackets (predominantly white or yellow) when delivering stones with light-coloured handles and dark-coloured shirts and playing jackets when delivering stones with dark handles (red is considered a dark colour).

Upper playing garments of all team members must be the same colour during the competition.

NUSF logo and sponsors logos

- NUSF logo and NUSF sponsors logos can be placed on the players' uniform according to the positioning described under "Positioning of Logos, Names and Advertising".
- Advertising in connection with alcohol, tobacco, commercial betting companies and drugs, as well as any signs or marks with reference to culture, race, or religion are not allowed.
- Only one logo is permitted in each of the described areas.
- The total logo size (edge to edge) shall not be greater than 10 cm and not greater than 100 cm²

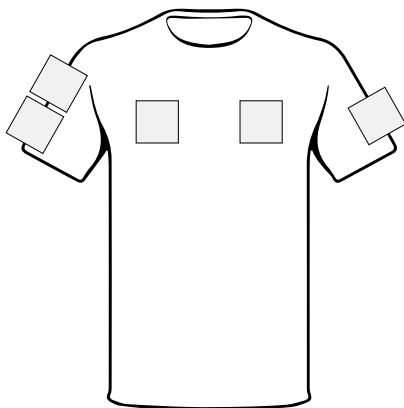

Positioning of Logos, Names and Advertising

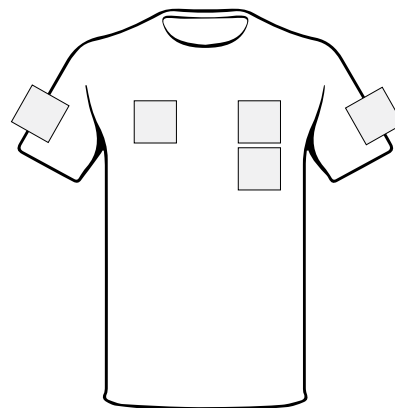
Jackets / Shirts

- Only one logo is permitted in each of the described areas.

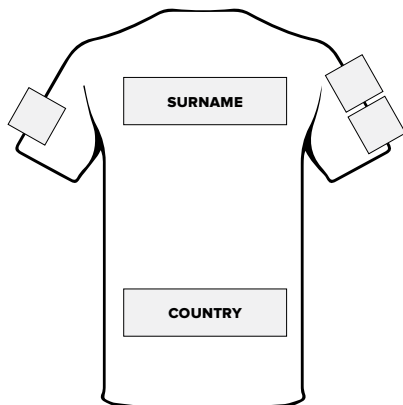
Option 1
Front



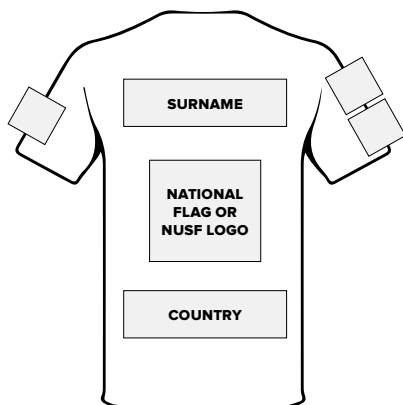
Option 2
Front



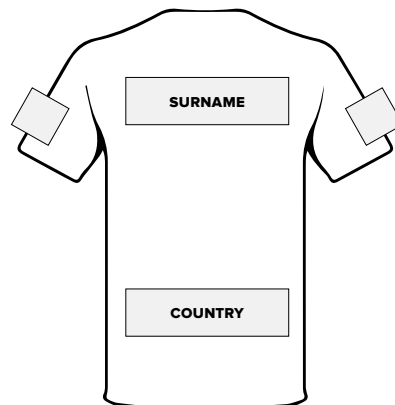

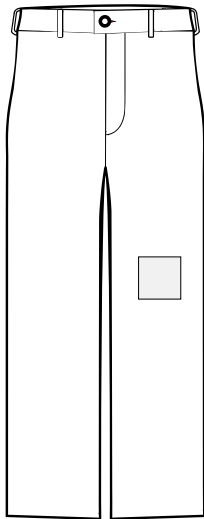
Positioning of Logos, Names and Advertising

Pants

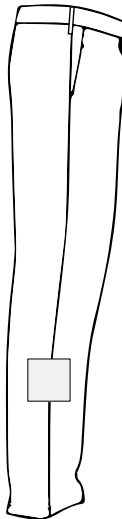
A NUSF sponsor logo can be added in one of the positions described below.

Team members do not need to wear the NUSF sponsor logo on the same leg (depends on the right or left handed), but the logo must be at the same height and location on the leg.

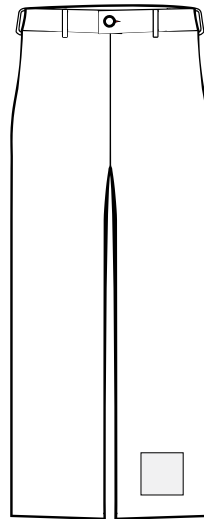
Leg - front

Leg - back

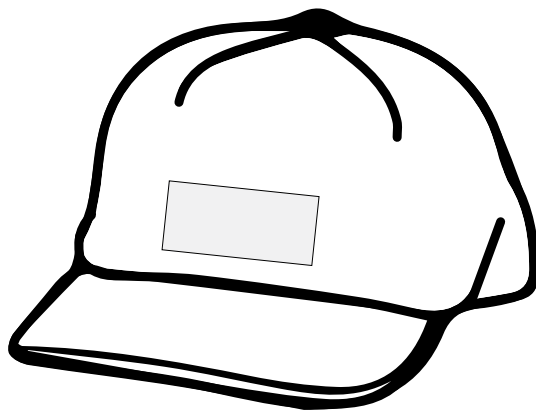
